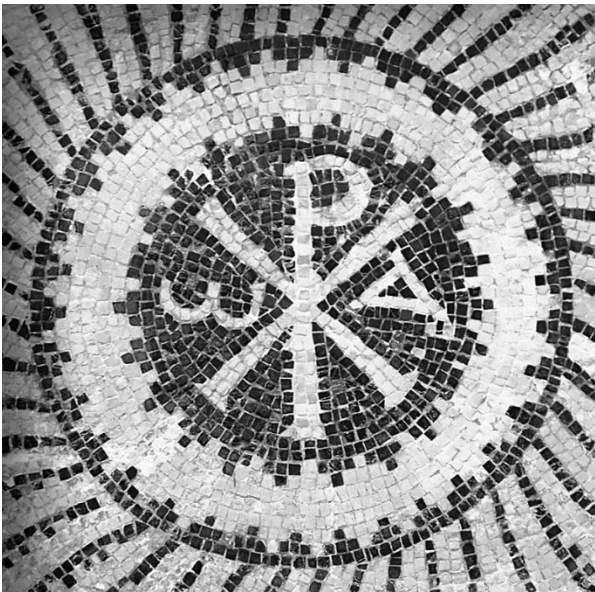
Look! He is coming with the clouds;

**John 18: 33 - 37**

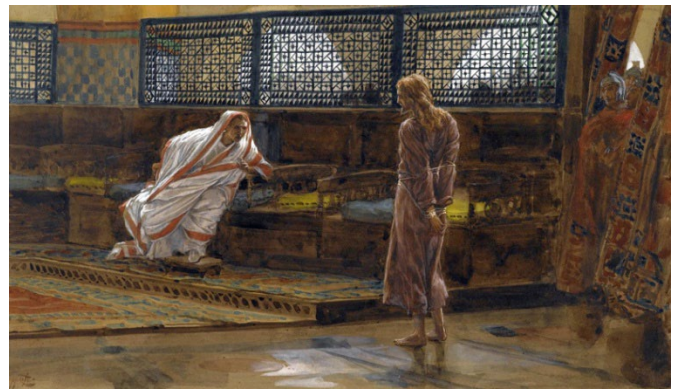
*Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, according to John*
